

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Compliance Statement

Mayflex UK Ltd is committed to meeting its obligations under the UK Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 (as amended).

As a B2B producer, Mayflex places electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) on the UK market for professional use. In accordance with the regulations, we provide a route for the responsible take-back, treatment, recycling, and recovery of WEEE arising from products we have supplied under Mayflex own brands at end of life.

Take-back of WEEE

Where applicable, Mayflex offers take-back of equipment supplied under its own brands to business customers when it reaches the end of its useful life, ensuring that waste electrical equipment is managed responsibly and does not enter general waste streams.

WEEE can be accepted free of charge at a Mayflex trade counter when delivered by the customer. Customers may arrange delivery of WEEE to Mayflex as required.

How the process works

Customers requiring WEEE take-back support can contact our Customer Services team to discuss appropriate arrangements.

Returned equipment is managed through approved and authorised waste treatment facilities to ensure appropriate treatment, recycling, and recovery in accordance with environmental legislation.

Compliance scheme

Mayflex UK Ltd is registered with an approved WEEE compliance scheme, Valpak, which supports us in meeting our legal obligations and maintaining ongoing compliance with the regulations.

Brand-specific information

Products sold under Mayflex own brands (including Excel) are supplied by Mayflex UK Ltd and form part of Mayflex's obligations under the UK WEEE Regulations.

Electrical and electronic equipment within scope is marked with the 'crossed-out wheeled bin' symbol in accordance with applicable standards (e.g. EN 50419).

This indicates that the equipment should not be disposed of with general waste and should be managed through appropriate WEEE take-back and recycling arrangements.

Customer responsibilities

Business customers are responsible for ensuring that WEEE is not disposed of with unsorted municipal waste and is handled in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements.
